Building Learning Power

We often talk to the children about how to be a good learner using our Learning Super Heroes. We have four Learning Heroes, Polly, Ryan, Chloe & Roger. They are represented by soft toys and are visible in each classroom. We use these characters to help the children talk about what makes a good learner and what super power for learning that they are using.

Polly Perseverance	Resilience, managing distractions, noticing, concentration
Ryan Reflectiveness	Revising, meta-learning, planning, distilling
Chloe Cooperation	Collaboration, interdependence, imitation, empathy, listening
Roger Resourcefulness	Reasoning, imagining, capitalising, making links, questioning

Wednesday 18th November is our Building Learning Power day. On that day we would like your child to think about their own learning super powers and come dressed up with a super hero cape. Please don't go to any expense, converting an existing super hero costume or decorating a pillowcase/ small sheet/blanket for a cape would be great!
