Carol Dweck's work about mindset is incredibly powerful, she talks about not putting lids on learning and teaching children the power of yet. We can respond to children saying 'I can't do it!' with 'Oh, you can't do it yet?' and this can be very empowering. Adding the word 'yet' we add the expectation that by trying again, trying a different way, practising or getting some help the task at hand might yet be achieved.
