What is or isn't appropriate is up to individual parents and carers to decide, and could be based on things like age, ability, beliefs and family values. Parental controls allow you to block and filter upsetting or inappropriate content. They work across your WiFi, phone network, individual apps and devices. Operation Encompass We are an Operation Encompass School. This means if the police ever attend an address and one of our children is registered as living there, we will be alerted via an email. This email contains the report written by an officer attending the call and their risk assessment of the situation. We are informed if a child is present at the time of the call, or not. If we receive one of these alerts via email one of our Designated Safeguarding Leads (Mrs Blake, Mrs Bancroft, Miss Cooper, Miss Jackson, Mrs Grainger, Miss Hammill, Miss Matthew & Mrs Sladden) will be in touch with you to check in and see if we can offer any support. On some occasion Children's Services will also contact us and request information from us or suggest ways we might be able to help.
