If there is any incident of unkind, disrespectful or unsafe behaviour we talk to children to find out what has happened listening to all sides of a story. Following these conversations we will apply logical consequences-these might be protective: time away from the playground, continuing learning in a different part of the classroom or in another classroom. Consequences might also be educational: learning about how their behaviour has impacted someone else, thinking about how they might make different choices in the future or helping repair damage that has been done to resources or property.
